1.2 Domain Name Database Management

THNIC Foundation has authorized Thai Name Server Co., Ltd. to serve as an official .th and .lne domain name registry. Thai Name Server Co., Ltd. has been managing the domain namzmaintenance for domain name registration data storage and data backup as well as providing DNS services. The company continuously adheres to accepted standards and follows news and recommendations for system improvement. In 2022, Thai Name Server Co., Ltd. received the ISO/IEC 27001:2013 Certificate No: IS 763878.




1.3 .th and .ไทย Domain Names Registration

THNIC Foundation has authorized T.H.NIC Co., Ltd. to serve as an official registrar responsible for .th and .lnu domain names. T.H.NIC Co., Ltd. operates according to the criteria and policies of the foundation's Domain Name Policy Subcommittee.


In 2022, T.H.NIC Co., Ltd. processed domain name registrations, transfers and deletions as requested by registrants. The number of registered domain names increased to 533 for .th and 1,747 for .lnu. As of the end of 2022, the number of registered IDN.th domain names was 3,643. (https://thnic.co.th/stats)

Additionally, premium IDN.th registrations were opened in 2022, which contributed to the increase in the number of IDN.th domain names.

1.5 Thai Business Promotion Project for Enhancing E-commerce Competitiveness



THNIC Foundation, in collaboration with the Department of Business Development, Ministry of Commerce; Thai Webmaster and Online Media Association; Thailand E-Commerce Association; Thai Digital Trade Association and Electronic Transactions Development Agency (ETDA), organized a project to promote Thai businesses' capabilities in e-commerce competition. This initiative encouraged

the use of domain names such as .co.th, online.th, or shop.th. Registered corporate entities or entrepreneurs with a DBD Registered trademark were eligible to apply for participation in the project. Participants received domain names ending in .co.th, .online.th, or shop.th, as well as a basic business website.

In the year 2022, training was conducted in collaboration with partner organizations. The training focused on providing a basic online marketing curriculum for businesses participating in the project. There were a total of nine topics covered, as follows:

1.6 Activities to promote the use of .th and .ไทย domain names

Asst. Prof. Dr. Pimonpan Chainan, Faculty of Mass Communication, Chiang Mai University, was interviewed on the topic: Awareness and Acceptance of Thai Language Domain Name Usage by Internet Users, on the program "Meuang Baan Yarn Thin" aired on Chula Radioplus FM 101.5 M-2 on February 17, 2022, from 10:05 to 10:30 a.m. [Link to the radio program: https://www.thnic.or.th/radio-demand-domain-thai/]



• Dr. Pensri Arunwatanamongkol, executive director of the THNIC Foundation, participated in a

discussion on Clubhouse titled "Domain Name System: The Heart of the Internet". The event was organized by the Thai IoT Association, and during the discussion, Dr. Pensri provided information on the importance of the domain name system in IoT and why domain names are crucial to the internet system. The conversation also highlighted the



significance of developing domain name and email systems that support local languages such as Thai or Universal Acceptance. Several experts, including Dr. Monsak Socharoentum, Dr. Panita Pongpaibool, Mr. Chaya Limchitti and Mr. Sura Ganintanasilp, joined the discussion. The session was moderated by Dr. Rusmimarn Keawsrikul and took place on March 23, 2022.

• In collaboration with the National Press Council of Thailand, council members were invited to register domain names in the Thai language. There were a total of 28 council members who registered domain names with .ไทย and .in.th extensions. Additionally, the council began using a website under the domain name "สภาการสื่อมวลชนแห่งชาติ.ไทย".

A workshop on creating online stores using Zavanna Sale Page was conducted by a group of local herbal soap and roasted chili paste with peanuts producers from Pak Nam Pran community and students from Pak Nam Pran Witthaya School, located in Pak Nam Pran sub-district, Pranburi district, Prachuap Khiri Khan province, on August 30, 2022.





• APAN53: On March 7, 2022, Dr. Pensri Arunwatanamongkol, executive director of the THNIC Foundation, was a speaker at APAN53. She discussed the importance of developing systems that allow domain names and email addresses to support local languages, such as the Thai language, or Universal Acceptance. She also emphasized the significance of using email for personal verification. In her presentation, Dr. Pensri provided recommendations, including promoting the importance of developing systems for Universal Acceptance.





• ICANN75: THNIC Foundation was invited by the Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG) to participate in the ICANN75 conference. Mr. Anawin Pongsaboripat, assistant director of the THNIC Foundation, represented THNIC Foundation as a delegate and served as a speaker in the session titled "Driving Local Change for UA Adoption Globally". The session aimed to present and exchange perspectives on driving the UA project for local languages in each country. Mr. Anawin presented the development of local language UA projects in Thailand, including the Thai language domain name (.ไทย) and Thai language email address (@คน.ไทย). A panel discussion included representatives from various countries, including China, Russia, India and Thailand.







Activities of BKNIX





Human resources development activities to enhance knowledge and expertise in internet technology under the THNIC Academy.

1. Baengpun Camp

The 3rd Baengpun Camp: High school and Vocational Certificate (Voc. Cert.) students from schools within Tak Province participated in the activity that took place from July 28 to 31and August 12 to 14, 2022. There were 28 participants in the Hackathon activity who competed in creating 5 websites: ตลาดแม่สอด.ไทย ตลาดวินเทจ.ไทย กาดโฮ้งต้าไทย and ตะลุยตากกาดนั่งยอง.ไทย.



2. Training at THNIC Academy, Tak Province

ability to understand and support Thai language domains and emails. The teams "THE FUTURABLE," "dy/dx," "Code Cool," "JAPPP!," "My beloved job," "วัยรุ่นนมผง," "Athena," "พารวย," "ปิดเทอมว่างมากๆ," and "DevFinite" successfully developed chatbots that recognize and support Thai language domains and emails. Prizes were provided by the THNIC Foundation. The event took place on April 25, 2022.



- An article, "The importance and necessity of Internationalized Domain Names (IDN) and Email Address Internationalization (EAI) as well as the development of systems to support Thai language domain names and emails" was published by Tecktalkthai through various channels such as websites and Facebook.
- The website, "รู้จัก.ไทย" by KhongPangKhongKwan: Codind Competition clip, a coding challenge! Faster means winning!", was promoted on the facebook page of KhongPangKhongKwan (at 2:20-minute mark) to introduce Thai language domain names, Thai language emails and the website "รู้จัก.ไทย".



 Mr. Anawin Pongsaboripat spoke at the THNIC Reseller Meeting on July 21, 2022, and invited resellers to join seminars and workshops on supporting local languages that THNIC Foundation organized in 2022. This included promoting online courses on setting up email servers to support the Thai language on Ubuntu.

• Mr. Anawin Pongsaboripat, assistant director of the THNIC Foundation, and Mr. Titipong Pak-insri, Operation and Support manager of Thai Name Server Co., Ltd., were speakers at the practical training workshop, "Developing EAI-Compliant Email Servers", for Computer Engineering Department students from the Faculty of Engineering, Thammasat University.

The workshop aimed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of email server installation in an easy-to-understand and efficient manner, supporting the use of Thai language emails. Participants were able to set up their own email servers and develop email server systems on the Ubuntu operating system. The workshop took place on October 19, 2022.



Mr. Anawin Pongsaboripat, assistant director of the THNIC Foundation, and Mr. Titipong Pak-insri, Operation and Support manager of Thai Name Server Co., Ltd., delivered a lecture to third-year students majoring in Computer Science at the Faculty of Science and Technology, Thammasat University. The purpose of the lecture was to provide students with knowledge about domain systems, the UASG organization and preparation of systems to support the .ไทย domain. They also provided an overview of the main content of the curriculum for developing EAI-compliant email servers, essential knowledge and preparation prior to the practical training. The lecture took place on November 4, 2565.



• THNIC Foundation organized a practical training on "Setting up an Email Server with EAI Support" for third-year students majoring in Computer Science at the Faculty of Science and Technology, Thammasat University. The training aimed to enable students to have their own email servers and develop email server systems on the Ubuntu operating system as well as to develop emails that support the Thai language. The training was conducted by Mr. Anawin Pongsaboripat, assistant director of the THNIC Foundation, and Mr. Titipong Pak-insri, Operation and Support manager of Thai Name Server Co., Ltd. It took place on November 21, 2022.
