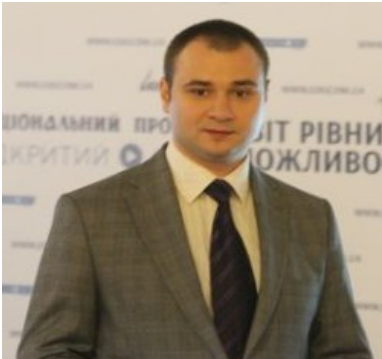


## Biography

### Dr. Oleksandr Tsaruk



Dr Oleksandr Tsaruk works as Chief Adviser for Committee on IT of Ukrainian Parliament where he is responsible for policy analysis and legislation improvement on e-commerce, e-communications and internet governance issues.

He is also known as an independent expert on e-commerce and finance issues in Ukrainian NGO community.

Since 2013 he is implementing plan on involving Committee on IT to local and International Internet Governance institutions in 2013. It have already boosted Committee efficacy on policy implementation. And let to mange a couple of important steps to civil society ideals. The closest activities I am plating to manage are Committee hearing on Safer Internet Day, Round table on Cyber Security, Broadband Internet National Plan etc.

Dr Tsaruk is member of council on IDN ccTLD .YKP the multi-stakeholder body which administrates country code top level domain of Ukraine and are the local enforcer of internet-UA Bylaw and innovations. As the IDN TLD Council we are working on developing e-mail service on IDN names to make possible to use such addresses as [Олександр@Царук.УКР](mailto:Олександр@Царук.УКР)

There are also long term plans on developing local Domain regulations and amendments to telecom Law of Ukraine.

He works on implementation NETMundial approaches to Ukrainian Internet Governance model and to find best practices how to make it more efficient. They have challenges with adoption of NETMundial principles and ideas of multi-stakeholderism in Ukraine practice because local stakeholder groups ware not ready to discuss the drafted memorandum on implementation MSH-UA mechanism at local IGFs.

Since 2014 Dr Tsaruk is a member of ICANN Governmental Advisory Committee as adviser. At September 2014 before 51 ICANN meeting He was considered as representative alternate of Ukraine to GAC ICANN.

At last ICANN meeting Dr Tsaruk was one of the founders of Cyrillic IDN panel where the issue of IDN email functioning was drawn more attention of all stakeholders. In such occasion to improve my understanding in IDNs on one hand and in the other he have been drawing the attentions of internet protocols experts to this important issue as government stakeholder to domain industry. The participation in IETF working groups and in Next Generation Leaders Programmes at the Internet Society are the next steps of promotion of IDN Domain/Email development.
